

PRAYER PROCLAMATIONS INSTRUCTIONS

It's TIME! **Saturday, Sept. 12th** at 8:00am LOCAL time (your time zone).

The goal is to have the 50 states speaking this over each state. There will be a wave of proclamations spoken across our nation for 6 hours!

SUGGESTED LOCATIONS: Pray about where awakening needs to come in your territory.

REMINDERS:

1. **PRAY, don't think, about where to do the Prayer Proclamations** the 2nd Sat. of each month. *Pray, rather than think.* God knows the best place. It could be a governmental building, but it also could be a parking lot and God knows something you do not.
2. These should be done OUTSIDE. We speak God's word over your city/county/community.
3. **START promptly at 8:00am local time**
4. God designed this to be simple so everyone can be involved. Therefore, we do not suggest you add anything to the 15 min time (unless otherwise specified for the month).
5. Everyone READ ALOUD TOGETHER.
6. Please do NOT post the declarations on social media.
7. **Post PICTURES to our Signal Thread - PrayerLink Pics group** or text to 941-681-5784.
 - Send a picture to us of your group each month. Type your county and the first names of each person in the message.
 - **STATES** - Please send us a picture of your group and tell us your state in the message!

Revival & Awakening

The words *Revival* and *Awakening* are often used interchangeably, they are two distinctly different things and one precedes the other. A revival in the church RESULTS in an awakening in the culture. *Revival* is a movement of God, the Holy Spirit, producing extraordinary results. *Revival* is nothing less than God Himself in the midst of His own people, causing deeper levels of repentance than ever before known, preaching even more soul searching and sound, prayer on an altogether different level and holiness that is not only genuine but impactful (*International Awakening Ministries*).

Revival is most certainly needed whenever there are proofs of spiritual death in and around the professing church. Growing evidence of the need of revival can be found in the growing conformity to the world in the passions, policies and practices in the Church. Today's church is also marked by a general disinterest in all things that make for true Christianity including holiness, fear of the Lord, and the redemption of lost souls (*International Awakening Ministries*). Feeling good has replaced being grounded. The Church has forgotten that truth does NOT change to accommodate feelings! It is evident that at no time in human history was revival more needed than today. We need a Revival in the Church that causes an Awakening in America and leads to an overall Reformation of our culture.

"As soon as it becomes evident that immorality is on the increase and spirituality is on the decline, the biblically sound and spiritually alive Church will not foolishly blame the world [*or the left*], but will immediately recognize its own complicity. The Church must first repent, for the righteous judgment was not against the world but against the church. Therefore, in times of spiritual declension and moral decadence, the great duty of every Christian is both to discover those sins which have caused the judgment and to put them away by that method which God Himself has chosen. The method God has chosen is the Solemn Assembly. Corporate sin must be dealt with by corporate repentance according to divinely ordained methods."

The Church: *Ekklesia*

Acts 13:1 From *Ek* (out of - G1577) *Kaleo* (called out ones - G2564). Meaning: A local assembly of called out ones. While this word is in Greek in the New Testament (Acts 7:38, 19:32; 1 Cor. 14:19, 34, 11:18; Heb. 2:12) it matches the Hebrew Old Testament word *qahal*, translated assembly or gathering (Deut. 31:30, 32:1; Joshua 8:35, 9:8). The *Ekklesia* is not a governing body, but rather an assembly or gathering of called out ones.

SPIRITUAL AWAKENING

REPENTANCE

Father, I acknowledge that sin pulls everything out of alignment. *“Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my thoughts. See if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting”* (Psalm 139:24). Forgive me, Lord, for my rebellion and for doing what is in my heart and in my mind.

Forgive me for being complacent and apathetic about to sin in our midst. I humble myself to a place of deep repentance for the times I have not stood for righteousness and have *“fellowshipped with the unfruitful works of darkness rather than expose them”* (Eph. 5:11).

I confess I have been wise in my own eyes and have not feared You, nor departed from evil (Prov. 3:7). Let me see sin the way You see it. Let me understand that there are no shades of grey; only good and evil.

Forgive us Lord, for not being *“known as men who sigh and cry for all the abominations that are done in the midst of our cities”* (Ezekiel 9:4), for *“not driving out the evil in our land,”* which has now become, *“pricks in our eyes and thorns in our sides and harasses us in the land where we dwell”* (Numbers 33:55).

Lord, I repent for *“laying aside the commandment of God and instead holding the traditions of men”* (Mark 7:8), for secularizing the celebration of the birth, death and resurrection of my Savior, Redeemer, and King.

Forgive the Church for compromising and incorporating pagan worship into our church activities with Easter egg hunts and fall festivals; for we have chosen to follow the culture of death rather than follow the Giver of life.

Forgive me for holding onto religious traditions above Your Word, by *“worshipping You in vain, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men”* (Mark 7:7). Forgive me for thinking religious feasts, communion, and sabbaths or any other religious activity can take the place of an intimate relationship with You (Col. 2:16-17).

THE CHURCH - *Ekklesia* (call out ones)

Elohim, we pray that the Church come to a place of repentance and return to her first love (Revelation 2:4-5). *“For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God”* (1 Peter 4:17).

Lord, bring us back to walking in reverential fear of our Creator God; with clean hands and pure hearts before You (Psalm 24:4), so that You may usher in a spiritual awakening.

“See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil” (Eph. 5:15).

Yahweh, AWAKE the Church, so we may see our nation saved. *“Awake, you who sleep” (Eph. 5:14) and put off envy and strife, “knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep” for “the night is far spent, the day is at hand” (Rom. 13:11-13).*

Father, we ask for a shift in churches and synagogues; that they begin to hunger and thirst for the Word and the Spirit of God (Psalm 42:1-2, 119:105).

We long to see people unite (Mark 3:25) in fervent prayer (James 5:16) and fasting (Esther 4:16, Luke 5:35), diligently seeking to know You, as we regularly read and follow Your Word (John 14:23).

We pray that churches are obedient in our efforts to preach the gospel to the lost and to make disciples (Matt. 28:19-20), to teach and empower the Body of Christ by speaking the truth of scripture (Eph. 4:12-16), to put on the armor of God and stand for righteousness (Eph. 6:10-20), to serve the poor (Prov. 19:17), to protect the vulnerable (Prov. 31:8-9), and to care for widows and orphans (1 Tim. 5:16, Psalm 82:3).

Our Nation

Lord, we ask for Your intent to be restored to America through the Church walking in Your ways (Psalm 119:1-7). For *“A Constitution of Government once changed from freedom, can never be restored, once lost is lost forever” (John Adams).*

We, the Church, contend for Your original intent for America: to birth this nation in peace, to reach people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ (Mark 16:15) and to disciple them (Matt. 28:19-20).

We ask You, Lord, to lift the veil over America so we may *“Seek Yahweh while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way and the unrighteous man his thoughts; and let him return to Yahweh, and He will have compassion on him, and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon” (Isaiah 55:6-7).*

Creator God, bring America to a place where she shall *“repent and return, so that our sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord” (Acts 3:19-20).*

We pray that our nation be so discontent with the current situation that its people grieve for our nation. Teach me how to *“weep between the porch and the altar” (Joel 2:17)* for our nation, our state, and our children’s future.

Lord, we want our nation to submit and draw near unto You. *“Therefore, submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded” (James 4:7).*

"Then we will not turn back from You; revive us, and we will call upon Your name. Restore us, O Lord God of hosts; cause Your face to shine, and we shall be saved!" (Ps. 80:18-19).

Restore the foundations of our nation! Remind us of the purpose and goals of the Founding Fathers for America.

We stand in agreement with the words attributed to Patrick Henry....

"It cannot be emphasized too strongly or too often that this great nation was founded, not by religionists, but by Christians; not on religions, but on the gospel of Jesus Christ. For this very reason peoples of other faiths have been afforded asylum, prosperity, and freedom of worship here."

"It is the duty of all Nations to acknowledge the providence of Almighty God, to obey His will, to be grateful for His benefits, and humbly to implore His protection and favors" (George Washington).

Therefore, *"Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering, for He is faithful that promised; and let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good words; not forsaking the assembling of ourselves; but exhorting one another and so much more as ye see the day approaching" (Heb. 10: 23-25).*

Kings of Kings and Lord of Lords, have mercy on America and bring us back to a righteous standing with You.

Let the United States of America stand strong and say, "IN GOD WE TRUST".
