- Pray that there is no violence or retaliation against any person(s) over the results, such as riots.
- Pray that God's will be done in this and every election. (Matt. 6:10)
- Pray for wisdom and discernment for God's choice of candidates. (Matt. 6:33)
- Pray that the lethargy and complacency that has infected so many people be lifted off and that a new fire of passion for turning this nation back to God is lit in every heart and spirit. (Amos 6:1)
- Pray for safety and protection for the candidates and their families. (Ps. 91:1-2)
- Pray against any violence that may be attempted on candidates and their families. (2 Thes. 3: 3)
